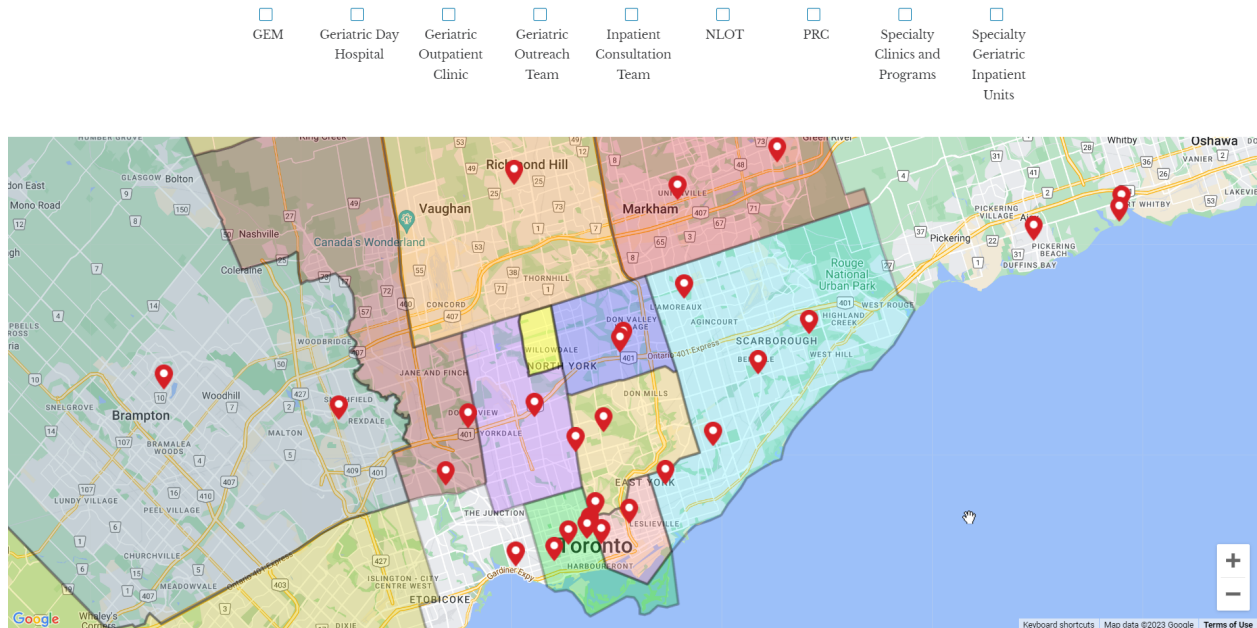

Some of them would sometimes have to put a pause on accepting new clients occasionally due to capacity issue (e.g. House Calls with Sprint) - please speak with colleagues at local social work and CCAC offices who would know the most up-to-date resources.

Friendly Reminders:

Patient and/or substitute decision makers should be in agreement with geriatric assessment before referral is sent (intake person at RGP will often check).

Please appreciate the sensitivity surrounding topics such as driving, functional independence, cognitive function, home visits...etc.
